Noticed some layout issues in the iPhone for the following card:  رأس = Head  Front - Image overlaps the writing Back - IPA text appears over the the Arabic. Also, lines are squashed at the bottom. I've been using this pronunciation trainer for a few weeks now, and there are two strange things I have realized that I am pretty sure are mistakes. The first is in the word for "The Merciful;" on the card the miim is the final form, but it's in the middle of the word (also it was spelled as I believe it should be in the pronunciation video). Maybe it's just me, but if it's not, then it should be fixed. The other thing was that there was a mention of the "l" sound in Arabic, but that it only appears in the word for Allah.
